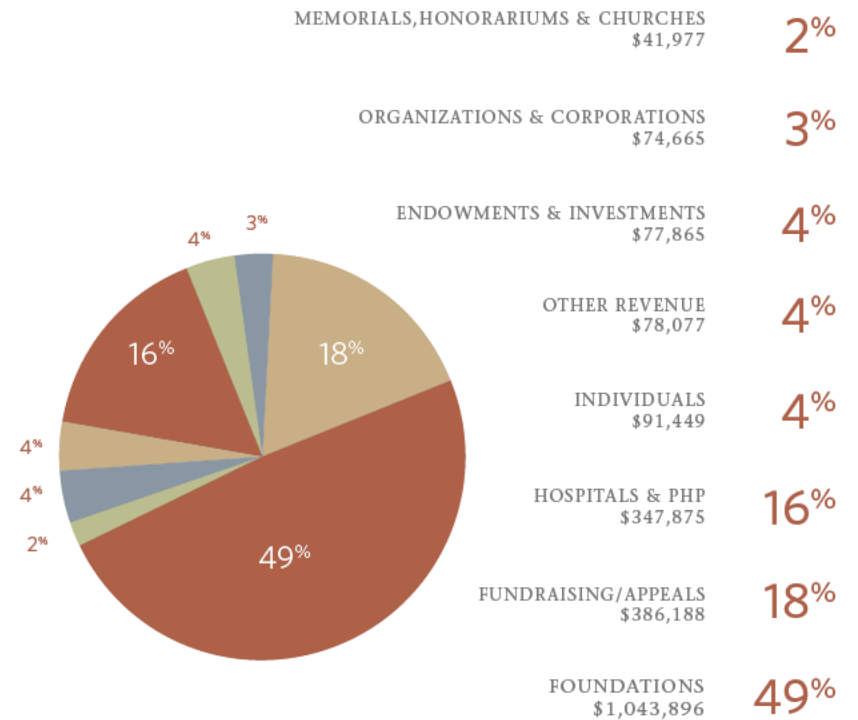
HEALING +
