Matthew 25 has been using **Fabric of the Community** since 2006 to share our vision and mission with our community. We strive to serve those in need of medical, dental, hearing and vision care so that our community can be a healthier, more productive place to live.

Just as a fabric is created by weaving individual fibers together, the Fabric of our Community is made up of all different types of individuals, groups and organizations weaving and working together to provide warmth when it is cold, food when hunger abounds, and health and dental care when illness, injury, or decay have taken a toll on our body. We at Matthew 25 feel blessed to live in a community with many great organizations and individuals with a sincere desire to come together and support each other. In doing so, we collectively create a stronger community.

We continue to serve the dental, medical, vision and hearing needs of over 100 people every day in specialized clinics designated for specific medical issues—vision, hypertension, and diabetes to name a few. We are working hard to establish more specific treatment for mental health and other needs in conjunction with our local universities and community resources. This type of treatment will bring needed assistance to people that would otherwise not be able to receive it.

On behalf of the entire board of Matthew 25, I cannot thank our individual and corporate donors enough for all the financial assistance they provide. As you know we continue to operate entirely on community support and without government funding. A dedicated staff of about 400 volunteers and 32 employed individuals manage the clinic and care for the patients day in and day out. The Patient Assistance Program obtains free medication for patients, the Med Room dispenses thousands of medications every year, the Dental Clinic helps prevent and correct dental problems, and the Medical Clinic treats illnesses and counsels patients toward a healthier lifestyle.

Our quality of care is characterized by Galatians 5:22-23:

*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy,
peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness,
faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.*

We strive to give people emotional support, love and hope as we meet their healthcare needs.
